



DOCUMENTATION NEEDED FOR CUSTOMS CLEARANCE (CARS AND SIMILAR VEHICLES)

Case 1: For Argentine returning citizens or foreigners with permanent visa ¹

- Original Passport
- Authorization letter, in order to do customs clearance on behalf of the customer. A public notary must certify the signature of the vehicle's owner.
- Consular Residence Certificate issued by the Argentinean Consulate at origin.
- Purchase receipt of the vehicle (translated into Spanish by a public translator)
- Title Deed (translated into Spanish by a public translator)

Case 2: For Foreigners who have Temporary Visa

- Original Passport
- Authorization letter, in order to do customs clearance on behalf of the customer. Public notary must certify the signature of the vehicle's owner.
- 2 Temporary Importation Forms ("IMPORTACION TEMPORAL DE AUTOMÓVILES O SIMILARES") filled by the customer and signed by a local company (instructions will be provided by **KRP moving**).
- Title Deed (translated into Spanish by a public translator).
- Purchase receipt of the vehicle (translated into Spanish by a public translator)
