



DOCUMENTATION NEEDED FOR CUSTOMS CLEARANCE OF HHGDS
(SEA SHIPMENT OR AIR SHIPMENT)

Case 1: For foreigners who have temporary visa ¹

- Original Passport
- Authorization letter, in order to do customs clearance on behalf of the customer. A public notary must certify the signature of the customer.
- Filled guarantee forms (“IMPORTACION TEMPORAL DE OBJETOS TRANSPORTADOS COMO EQUIPAJE”), signed by the legal representative of the Argentinean Company that hires the customer. This Company must be registered at Customs as Importer/Exporter. In case customer doesn't have this type of support from a local company, then he'll have to obtain a guarantee certificate from a local Insurance Company. The cost of this document varies depending on the shipment's value.

Case 2: For Argentine citizens or foreigners with permanent visa

- Original Passport
- Authorization letter, in order to do customs clearance on behalf of the customer. A public notary must certify the signature of the customer.
- In case they are coming from a bordering country, they'll need to obtain a Consular Residence Certificate issued by the Argentinean Consulate at origin.
